PL Przed rozpoczęciem montażu mebla wszystkie elementy należy sprawdzić czy nie są uszkodzone. W przypadku wykrycia uszkodzenia elementu należy odstąpić od montażu mebla i złożyć reklamację. Montaż produktu w oparciu o uszkodzone elementy oznacza akceptację ich stanu przez Kupującego, co powoduje, że reklamacja uszkodzonych elementów nie będzie uznawana.

- **aggressive chemical substances** as well as **abrasive cleaning agents** or **solvents**. They may damage the surfaces too;
- **scouring powder**, **steel wool** or **scouring pads**. They destroy the surface so badly that reconditioning is impossible;
- **vacuum cleaners**. The nozzles and brushes can cause scratches on the surfaces; **steam cleaners**. The surfaces may be damaged or separated from the ground due to the high pressure and heat of the water vapour.
